What is TechGirls?

TechGirls is an international summer exchange program designed to equip young innovators and STEM professionals from the U.S. and select countries around the world with technical skills and networks to contribute to their home economies and address global challenges through technology and STEM careers. Who should apply? If you...

- Are a girl between the ages of 15-17 from one of the following countries/territories: Albania, Algeria, Cambodia, Cameroon, Costa Rica, Cyprus, Ecuador, Egypt, Fiji, Greece, Indonesia, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Kyrgyzstan, Lebanon, Kosovo, Mongolia, Montenegro, Morocco, Nigeria, Pakistan, Palestinian Territories, Panama, Peru, Rwanda, South Africa, Suriname, Taiwan, Tajikistan, Tunisia, Türkiye, Turkmenistan, United States, Uzbekistan, Vietnam, and Zambia.
- Have a demonstrated interest in one or more STEM fields and intend to pursue higher education or a career in STEM.
- Are committed to completing a follow-on project.
- Have at least one semester of secondary school remaining after the program.
